<u>Fees</u> A reminder Fees are increasing after the Easter Holidays to £16.50 per session . Please can you ensure all fees are paid the <u>minimum of a week in advance for parents and by no later than your</u> <u>childs first booked session for the week. If paying monthly these also must be paid a minimum of 1 month in advance.</u> Can we also remind you <u>6 weeks notice</u> is required to any changes to your sessions, these do not include school holidays, and you are still required to pay for your child's sessions when your child is absent due to illness or holidays.

<u>Summer Club</u>— We have had quite a few parents interested in the summer club which will operate from Monday 31st July-11th August from 9-3pm. The fees will be the same as the preschool at £16.50 per session 9-12,12-3. Unfortunately 30 hour funding will not cover this as this is only for term time sessions however you may be eligible for taxfree childcare, if you visit the Government website this will provide you with further information. Please can you email or let the preschool know if anyone else is interested by no later than 17th March 2023.

<u>30 hour funding</u> For any child who is 3 before 31 December 2022 who would like to attend additional sessions to their 15 hour entitlement please visit www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to see if you are eligible for up to 30 hour funding. Parents who are eligible will need to bring in to us their 11 digit code and parents name and NI number. Please note at Holne Chase we have limited sessions remaining for the rest of the year so please inform us asap if you wish to increase your child's sessions for April 2023. Children who are already receiving this please remember to log into your account and update your details every 3 months, if you do not complete this update you will be invoiced for your child's sessions thank you.

<u>Red Nose Day</u> On Friday 17th March it is Red nose day, as well as St Patricks Day. We are inviting the children to come in dressed up in something red or something for St Patricks day for a 50p donation all funds raised will go to Red Nose day.

Arrivals and Collection of your children

A reminder the times for arrival and collection for your children we have to strictly follow to ensure safety for all in a case of a fire, evacuation etc. Please can you support us by dropping your child off and collecting between the following times:

Morning session– Doors open 9am and close for registration 9:10am. (We can re-open the door for late arrivals after registration 9:30am)

Collection from morning session: Doors open 11:50-12noon

Arrival for Afternoon session– 12 noon and close for registration 12:10 (we can re-open the door for late arrivals 12:30)

Collection from Afternoon session: Doors open 2:50-3pm. Any child who needs to be collected earlier due to having to collect children from other schools not located next to the preschoollplease can you do this between 2:20-2:35pm.
